Questions/ Answers



If i'm in poor health, can I still get vaccinated ?

Yes. Diabetis, cancer, rare illnesses.. get vaccinated in order to avoid Covid complications.

If I already had Covid19, can I still get vaccinated ?

Yes. I can get vaccinated 6 months after contamination, and only one shot of vaccine is necessary.

Should I expect side effects?

Yes. Discomfort, tiredness, fever... if side effects are too intense or lasting, contact your doctor.

Is one shot of vaccine enough?

Ask a practitioner. One shot is not always enough, take this into account while scheduling your appointments.

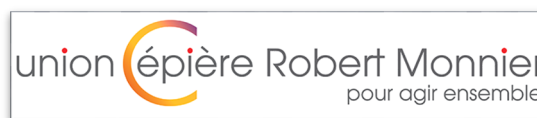

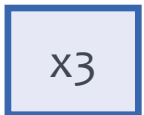
Prevention



In

order to protect yourself and others, it is absolutely necessary to respect the following preventive measures:

- Wear a mask in public
- Wash your hands regularly
- Cough/sneeze into your elbow
- Use paper tissues
- Open the windows and ventilate 3 times a day for 15mn
- Respect social distancing



Being vaccinated does not guarantee a finite protection. **In any case, be respectful of preventive measures.**

When should I get detected ?

When you feel symptoms, such as:

- Cough
- Fever
- Respiratory problems
- Loss of taste and smell
- Fatigue
- Sore muscles...

Or if you were in contact with a covid positive person.

Where to get detected ?

In your **pharmacy**: antigenic tests are available if you start feeling symptoms.

Detection centers: RT- PCR tests are available at any time.
